Numerous custom and specialized auto service and repair businesses were based in the Alley during the heyday of American hot-

rodding, as were two of the Washington, DC, area's most active and important hot rod clubs: the DC Dragons (in 1957 and 1958) and the Silver Spring Ram Rods (from 1962 to 1975).

After Ford unsuccessfully attempted to buy Ferrari, in 1963, the American car giant instead embarked on its own racing programme in a bid to beat the famous Italian marque at the world's most prestigious race, the Le Mans 24 Hours, as told in the forthcoming Hollywood movie Ford v. The magic lives on: the book's concluding sections show surviving cars at differing stages in their later life and bring the story up to date with developments since the 2005 edition.
