Volume IV of A Corpus of Rembrandt Paintings deals uniquely with the self-portraits of Rembrandt. In a clearly written explanatory style the head of the Rembrandt Research Project and Editor of this Volume, Ernst van de Wetering, discusses the full body of work of paintings and etchings portraying Rembrandt. He sets the different parameters for accepting or rejecting a Rembrandt self-portrait as such, whilst also discussing the exact working environment of Rembrandt and his apprentices. This workshop setting created a surroundings where apprentices could be involved in working on Rembrandt paintings making it more difficult to determine the hand of the master. Van de Wetering, who is one of the Rembrandt experts of our day and age, goes down to great detail to explain how the different self-portraits are made and what techniques Rembrandt uses, also giving an overview of which paintings are to be attributed to the Dutch Master and which not. In the additional catalogue the self-portraits are examined in detail. In clear and accessible explanatory text the different paintings are discussed, larded with immaculate images of each painting. Details are shown where possible, as well as the results of modern day technical imaging like X-radiography. This work of art history and art research should be part of every serious art historical institute, university or museum. Nowhere in the art history have all Rembrandt's self portraits been discussed in such detailed and comparative manner by an authority such as Ernst van de Wetering. This is a standard work for decades to come.

Transformations of Romanness - Walter Pohl 2018-07-09

Roman identity is one of the most interesting cases of social identity because in the course of time, it could mean so many different things: for instance, Greek-speaking subjects of the Byzantine empire, inhabitants of the city of Rome, autonomous civic or regional groups, Latin speakers under 'barbarian' rule in the West or, increasingly, representatives of the Church of Rome. Eventually, the Christian dimension of Roman identity gained ground. The shifting concepts of Romanness represent a methodological challenge for studies of ethnicity because, depending on its uses, Roman identity may be regarded as 'ethnic' in a broad sense, but under most criteria, it is not. Romanness is indeed a test case how an established and prestigious social identity can acquire many different shades of meaning, which we would class as civic, political, imperial, ethnic, cultural, legal, religious, regional or as status groups. This book offers comprehensive overviews of the meaning of Romanness in most (former) Roman provinces, complemented by a number of comparative and thematic studies. A similarly wide-ranging overview has not been available so far.

Dopo aver realizzato moltissime imprese sugli Ottomila e dopo una cinquantina di prime, Hans Kammerlander si è posto un nuovo traguardo: la salita delle seconde vette più alte dei sette continenti, un progetto decisamente attraente per un alpinista come lui, soprattutto perché la salita di queste montagne presenta più difficoltà delle cosiddette Seven Summits, che oggi sono montagne «di moda», spesso prese d'assedio dagli alpinisti. Il progetto di Kammerlander delle Seven Second Summits è diventato un viaggio intorno al mondo che lo ha condotto dal K2 in Asia all'Ojos del Salado al margine del deserto di Atacama in America Meridionale, dal Mount Kenia fino al Polo Sud e nella giungla della Nuova Guinea. Kammerlander ha attraversato ghiacciai sterminati così come fitte foreste ricche di orchidee e ananas. Ha fatto la conoscenza del «re dei bush pilot», ha sperimentato il talento nell'improvvisare degli alpinisti russi, ha incontrato portatori con gli stivali di gomma che nonostante la pioggia ininterrotta non hanno mai perso il buon umore. Poi però proprio il Mount Logan, considerato facile anche se molto imponente, che Hans Kammerlander aveva salito nel 2010, ha sollevato una serie di polemiche perché Kammerlander, a quanto pare, non aveva raggiunto la vetta principale, bensì una secondaria: nessun problema. Con una nuova salita a due anni di distanza, Kammerlander ha fugato ogni dubbio sul fatto che il record delle Seven Second Summits gli spettasse di buon diritto. Fino alla prossima impresa.

**Butrint 7** - David Hernandez 2020-12-14

This volume brings together unpublished Italian and Albanian archaeological reports and new archaeological studies from recent fieldwork that throw new light on the archaeology and history of the Pavllas River Valley, the Mediterranean alluvial plain in the territory of Butrint, ancient Buthrotum, in southwestern Albania. It gives prominence for the first time to two important sites, Kalivo and Çuka e Aitoit, which are here reinterpreted and shown to have played major roles in the early history of Butrint as it evolved in the later first millennium BC to emerge as the key city of Chaonia in Epirus. Butrint 7 also presents the full excavation report of the Late Bronze Age and Hellenistic fortified site of Mursi, in addition to other Butrint Foundation surveys and excavations in the hinterland of Butrint, including the Roman villa maritima at Diaporit, the villa suburbana on the Vrina Plain, and Roman sites on Alinura Bay and at the Customs House, as well as new surveys of the early modern Triangular Fortress and a survey to locate the lost Venetian village of Zarópulo. The volume also features a new study of the Hellenistic bronze statuette of Pan found on Mount Mile and of his sanctuary at Butrint. The volume concludes with a comprehensive reassessment of the Pavllas River Valley in relation to Butrint, from the Palaeolithic to the modern eras, examining how dominion, territory, environment and the 'corrupting sea' reshaped Butrint and its fluvial corridor diachronically and particularly brought profound territorial, economic and social alterations under the Roman Empire.
