Aristid Lindenmayer introduced language-theoretic models for developmental biology in 1968. Since then the models have been commonly referred to as L systems. Of the many who could not contribute, we in particular regret the absence of A. Ehrenfeucht, G. Herman and H.A. Maurer whose influence in the theory of L systems has been most significant.
