The Biophysics of Cell Membranes - Richard M. Epand 2017-09-25

This volume focuses on the modulation of biological membranes by specific biophysical properties. The novelty of the methods proposed and their potential for a deeper molecular description of membrane functioning are particularly relevant experts in the areas of biochemistry, biophysics and cell biology, while also presenting clear and thorough introductions, making the material suitable for students in these fields as well.
